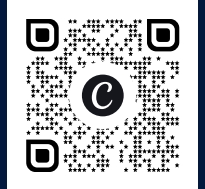

Public procurement decisions can be high-profile, high-value and highly scrutinized. Elected officials and senior leaders influence governance, oversight, organizational priorities and major decisions—even when they do not manage the procurement process directly.

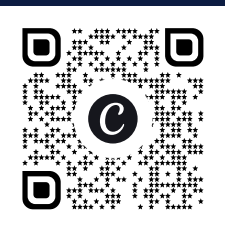
